Respected Madam/Sir,

As you are aware the National Education Policy 2020 emphasizes the creation of motivated, energized, and capable faculty. The capacity building of the faculty at all levels has been one of the major thrust areas in the field of Higher Education. Existing mechanisms for capacity building of faculty, i.e. UGC-Human Resource Development Centres (HRDCs) and Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (PMMNMTT) Centres are contributing immensely towards training faculty of Higher Education Institutions to provide more effective teaching. 
